

# Deming Hall Women



Deming Residence Hall for women was built adjoining the west wing of Lovett Hall in 1969. It included a new cafeteria, Henderson Dining Hall. It was named in honor of Myrtle Deming '19, who was employed as stenographer, executive secretary, registrar and vice president for business affairs, either part-time or full-time, from 1917-1974, a record of 57 years of service to Findlay. Henderson Dining Hall was expanded in 1999 and again in 2003 when Sodexo Marriott introduced new food formats, which have won accolades from students.
