Lab Instructor Positions in Biology

The University of Findlay invites applications for two full time, non-tenure-track positions as laboratory instructors in biology in the University's College of Sciences to begin in August 2010.

Candidates for a position as **Lab Instructor in Biology** must hold a minimum of a Master's degree in the biological sciences and have the ability to teach a wide range of laboratory courses including field courses and molecular-based courses. Ability to assist in general chemistry laboratory courses is also desirable.

Candidates for a position as **Lab Instructor in Anatomy** must hold a minimum of a Master's degree in the biological sciences, preferably anatomy, and be able to teach lecture and laboratory classes in anatomy and physiology and introductory biology courses.

Prior teaching experience is preferred. Candidates must be committed to student-centered education as well as professional development and scholarship, including engagement in undergraduate research.
