**Coordinator of Clinical Education**

The University of Findlay Physician Assistant Program invites applications for the full-time position of Coordinator of Clinical Education with faculty appointment in the College of Health Professions.

Primary responsibilities include scheduling, coordinating, monitoring, and enhancing clinical learning opportunities and outcomes of clinical practice students, and the on-going development of new clinical education affiliates. As core faculty, responsibilities span teaching, service, and scholarship and include student mentorship, classroom teaching (lecture and small group activities) in areas of expertise/interest, participation in admission processes, program evaluation, accreditation self-study, committee service, and other related duties as delegated.

Qualifications: NCCPA certification and eligibility for licensure in Ohio, master's degree, a minimum of three years clinical experience as a practicing PA, the ability to travel to clinical affiliate sites, and excellent writing and computer skills. Strong communication and organizational skills, prior teaching experience, and a clinical background in emergency medicine or surgical services will be considered highly desirable assets.
