Tenure-Track Position in Physics

The University of Findlay invites applications for a tenure-track position in physics to begin August 2010.

Candidates will be expected to teach general physics (including laboratories) to undergraduate students in the life sciences and health professions, as well as a general education course in astronomy. Prior teaching experience is preferred and a PhD in physics or engineering is required. Rank as assistant or associate professor and salary are commensurate with qualifications. Candidates must be committed to student-centered education as well as professional development and scholarship, including engagement in undergraduate research. Preference will be given to candidates with interests and research experience in biomedical physics or biomedical engineering.
