Tenure-Track Position in Physical Therapy

The University of Findlay invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position in Physical Therapy to begin in July 2010 in the University's Doctor of Physical Therapy Program.

Responsibilities include teaching theory and clinical courses in the Doctorate of Physical Therapy program. Candidates must hold a DPT with Board certification or a terminal doctorate in a related field. An Ohio Physical Therapy license or eligibility for licensure in Ohio and a minimum of three years of clinical experience are required. Prior teaching experience is preferred. Rank as assistant or associate professor and salary are commensurate with qualifications. Candidates must be committed to student-centered education as well as professional development and scholarship.
