GEN-002	Wireless Internet Policy	06/01/2008

Policy Description— Students, faculty, staff, and permitted guests may use the University’s wireless network, subject to the terms and conditions of the Acceptable Usage Policy. Unauthorized wireless access points are not to be placed on the University network. To safeguard individual privacy and preserve the security of UF data and other systems on the Internet, ITS will disable the Ethernet ports to which unauthorized wireless access points are attached. Those ports will be re-enabled after unauthorized wireless access points have been removed.

Definitions—

Wireless Network—The ability to be connected to the Web or any other Internet or network resource without a physical connection to the network.

Wireless Access Points—Devices that allow computers and other appliances the ability to gain access to the Internet wirelessly.

Rationale for Policy— To safeguard individual privacy and preserve the security of UF data and other systems on the Internet, ITS will disable the Ethernet ports to which unauthorized wireless access points are attached.
