¹ Rate for undergraduate classes is calculated as the rate shown times the undergraduate workload calculated for the instructor. For most undergraduate classes, the instructor's workload is the same as the student credit hours. Exceptions include instruction at ACI which adds one workload unit per class, and some classes which accrue extra workload.

² Rate for graduate classes **includes** the 4/3 credit hour workload multiplier that applies for most graduate classes. Thus, compensation is the rate shown times the number of student credit hours. Independent studies, and culminating and capstone project activity are calculated separately.

³ Administrative employees may teach one course during other than regular work hours during each semester or summer for compensation with approval of their supervisor and the Vice President for Academic Affairs.
