

*What does the DHS regulation say about online classes?* The regulation states that a student may not count more than one online class towards their full time registration requirement. This does not mean you can not take more than one online class but it does mean you can only count one online class towards the full time requirement.

*Can all my registered courses be online even if I'm on CPT?* No. You can never have a class registration showing all online classes even on CPT.

*If it is my last term and I only have one class left, may I take this class online?* No. If you have only one class remaining for your last term, that class must be taken live.

*What if I am taking an additional concentration or strand and my remaining classes to complete the concentration/strand are only offered online?* If there are any available live electives, you must take the live elective even if it does not completely fit with your concentration/strand or ask your advisor to do an independent study in place of one of the online classes. You can never have just online classes as your registration.

*Can I take online classes on a break?* Yes. You can take all online classes during a quarter/semester break. There are no class requirements if you are on break. The classes will not, however, count as a full time registered quarter/semester since it is your break.

*Can I take online classes and take them from my home country?* Yes. You can register for online classes and take them from back home.
