

## International Applicant Check Sheet

### HEALTH PROFESSIONS APPLICANT (AT/OT/PA/PHARMD/PT)

NOTE: At no time are faxed, scanned, simple copies, or notarized copies of international credentials to be accepted for admission consideration. For those countries providing attested copies, see the approved Attestation policy.

Note: Due to the unique nature of the requirements for Health Profession admission consideration, applicants to these programs are considered on a case-by-case basis, and may not be eligible for direct admission consideration into the Master's or Professional portion of their desired program. The basic application procedures are as follows:

Information required for admission consideration:

	Application stating the term desired at UF, the Health Profession program of study desired, and level of program (Undergraduate, Transfer, Master's)
	Original and official credentials showing completion and awarding of the appropriate level of education for the level of program desired. If not issued in English, then a certified English translation along with the original language credential is required, and, if a copy of an original, the copy must be attested by an appropriate educational official within the home country and the applicant is required to produce original educational credentials upon enrollment. See approved Attestation policy.

The following items are not required for admission consideration, but will be required after the admission decision is made:

	Financial documents required prior to issuance of I-20

While the following are not required for admission consideration, they are required upon enrollment at UF. Please note the consequences of failure to provide these items.

	A verified OFFICIAL TOEFL score. Failure to provide this will result in taking at least one term in the Intensive English Language Program (IELP).
	An OFFICIAL ACADEMIC IELTS provided in lieu of TOEFL. NOTE: If presented with a GENERAL TRAINING IELTS, it cannot be accepted for language waiver, and if no ACADEMIC IELTS or TOEFL provided, this will result in taking at least one term in the Intensive English Language Program (IELP).
	Three letters of recommendation for MPT consideration. Two letters of recommendation for MOT; MAT doesn't require letters of recommendation.
