Guidelines

Admission for the UF-USA dual enrollment program

These courses are taken AT your high school and are taught by your high school teachers who have been trained by UF faculty. The UF-USA program is not associated with the state-funded PSEO program in which high school students take UF courses at UF.

This application will not be processed without an official high school transcript.

Any High School Student applying for the UF-USA program must have and maintain a minimum **3.2 cumulative GPA** to participate.

Registration for more than 3 courses requires a 3.6 cumulative GPA or a letter of recommendation from the guidance counselor. A maximum of 18 hours can be taken per year.

Course Enrollment Regulations

- I understand that a \$250.00 fee will be charged by The University of Findlay to cover the cost of the 3-credit course (\$300 for 4-hour course). My family will be responsible for paying this fee to my school district unless my school district has made arrangements with The University of Findlay to cover this expense. I also understand that I am responsible for this tuition charge once I submit this application form and will abide by all University of Findlay financial and registration policies and procedures.
- **High schools must submit student applications by January 15th for the spring 2010 semester to The University of Findlay.**
- Registered students who withdraw from spring courses and notify the University after February 15th will not receive any refund or adjustment. School districts must remit payment to The University of Findlay by March 30th.
- Students will receive billing statements from The University of Findlay until payment has been made by your school district. **DO NOT PAY THIS TUITION TO THE UNIVERSITY.**
- **Registered students who withdraw from spring courses and notify the University after March 23rd will receive a letter grade of “F” for the course.**
- Students applying for fall semester courses must fill out a fall application for those courses.
