A Message from the Dean

Students in the College of Sciences (COS) pursue degrees in majors as diverse as animal science, biology, chemistry, computer science, environmental health and safety, equestrian studies, mathematics and pre-veterinary studies. Faculty in the COS provide gateway courses in the sciences that are foundational for specializing in other majors, most importantly those in the College of Health Professions and pharmacy. A strong and growing activity for all COS students is undergraduate research in which the faculty act as mentors in teaching students the process of doing science for both pure and applied topics. Exceptional students capitalize on skills that bridge several majors. For example, Jonathon Combs, a senior biology major with a goal of studying infectious diseases, uses computer applications to discover historical relationships among organisms from sequences of DNA, computes population sizes and the life history of animal populations from mark-release-recapture data, and investigates dynamic change in viruses that cause Lassa fever by "mining" data from digital data banks. Positive interactions between keen students and a dedicated faculty are indicative of continuous and reciprocal active learning – a hallmark of the College of Sciences.

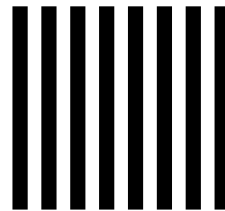

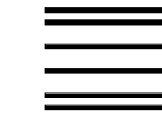
