Policy Description—Any computer connected to the UF network is required to have up-to-date anti-virus software, anti-spyware software, current operating system security patches, and the UF Security Notification software.

The first time users connect their computer to the UF Network, they will be asked to download a small program that runs in the background and transmits information about their computer's software back to the NAC. After this is installed, computers failing to meet any of the requirements will be sent notification with directions for addressing deficiencies.

The list of computer requirements is:

- Up-to-date operating system and patches, including Windows XP >=SP2, Windows 2000 >=SP4, Windows Vista, Windows 7, Mac OS >=10.4.5, and Linux
- Up-to-date Anti-virus Software with current definitions
- Up-to-date Anti-spyware Software with current definitions
- UF Emergency Notification system (Lynx)
- Sun Java Runtime Environment 1.5 or later

Definitions—

Network Access Control (NAC)—System for gaining access to the UF network.
