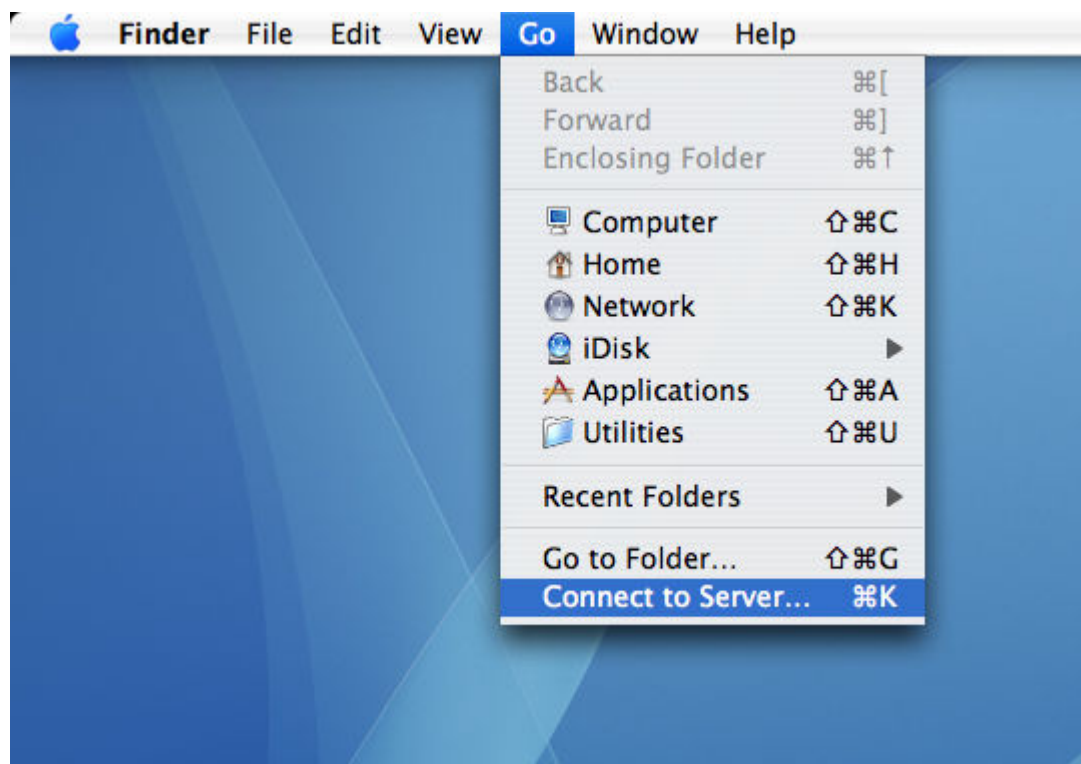
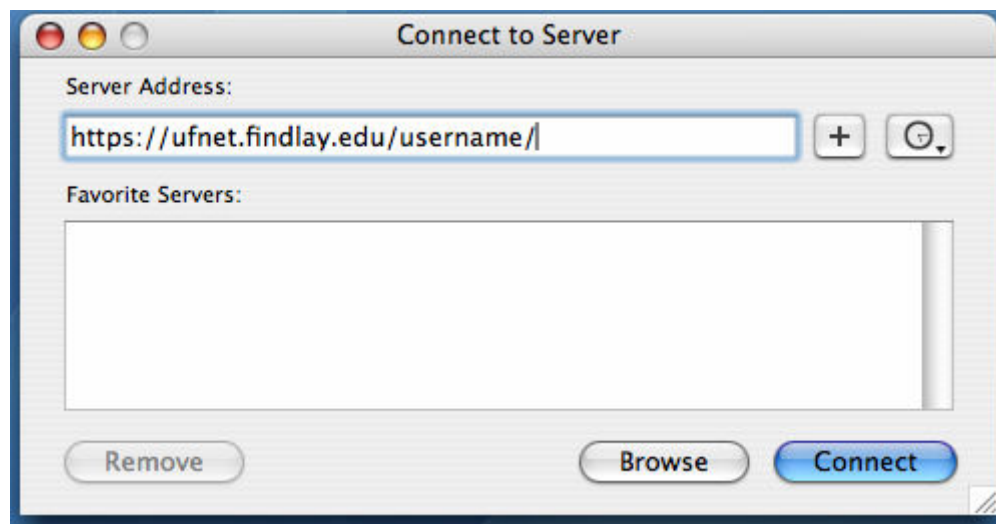


# Connecting to Your UFnet Home Directory from Mac OSX

Click on “Go” and “Connect to Server” from the MacOS Taskbar.



You will now be presented with the following “Connect to Server” box.

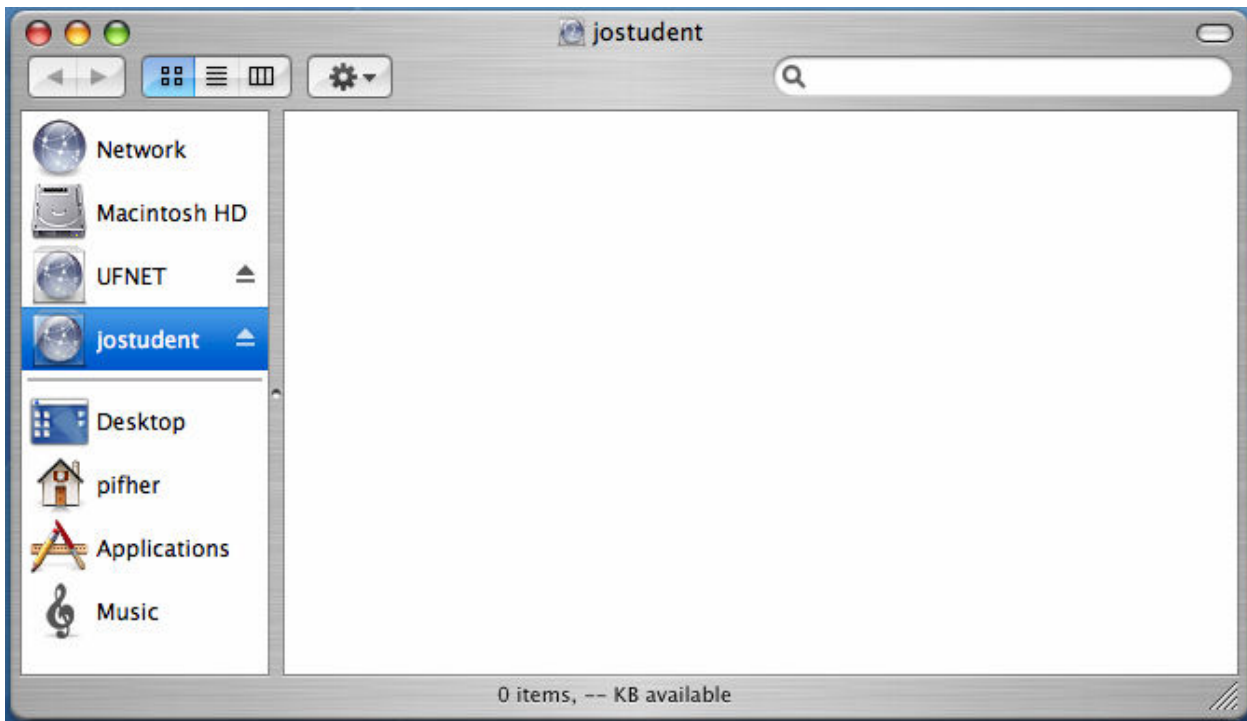


In the “Server Address:” box, type the URL of your UFnet Home Directory as shown above. (Remember to replace “username” with your UFnet username – you will not need to put the @findlay.edu portion. Also remember to use https:// to ensure that your connection is encrypted). Once you have typed the URL, click the “Connect” button.

You will now be presented with the following logon screen.



On this screen type your UFnet username (complete with the @findlay.edu) and password and click the "Ok" button to establish the connection. Your UFnet Home Directory will now open in the Finder. You can then simply drag and drop your files in the right pane to copy them to your Home Directory.



There will also be a shortcut to your UFnet Home Directory on your Desktop. To disconnect, drag this



icon to the trashcan.
