Clinician: Jim Arrigon, USEF Hunter/Equitation judge, ETS Founder and Director. Beckett Run Riding LLC, North Carolina; He coached at 41 National Team Championships (28 IHSA, 10 IEA, and 3 NCAA), is credited with more than 30 National Champion blue ribbons and 19 IHSA Regional Champion Teams with Murray State University, Miami University of Ohio, Ohio State, and Liberty University. His Beckett Run team was 2009 IEA National Champs, the first "barn" team to beat the prep schools. He is the only person to coach National Champion teams in NCAA, IHSA, and IEA, and was also team captain on two-time IHSA National Champion teams in college. More recently, coached Liberty University to Regional Champion Team and Holiday Tournament Champion team in 2017, and Ohio University to 4th Place at 2019 Tournament Series. His Miami University team was Top 6 at IHSA Nationals 11 times in a 15 year stretch, won 3 Tournament of Champions and Series Champion, and won NCAA National Invitational Championship twice. IHSA's National Secretary for 25 years, honored with IHSA Lifetime Achievement Award in 2005, and actively judges IHSA and IEA horse shows. BS, MS, University of Kentucky. His son was a Team Captain for Miami and coached National Champs of his own at University of Lynchburg and St. Andrews University, and daughter was a Team Captain for Vanderbilt University. His wife was a longtime IEA Director, and is now Mayor of Gibson, North Carolina.



Clinician: Brittany Friesner, University of Findlay Hunter Head Coach. Brittany was a Team Captain for Findlay, later graduate assistant, and has coached several IHSA National Champions and reserve champions. After graduation, she worked at Limelight Farm in Bedford, New York, training riders and horses for AA rated horse shows and coached a successful IEA team. As assistant coach at Bridgewater College in Virginia, she coached a top 3 finisher at IHSA Nationals, as well as the champion of the IHSA Metropolitan Equitation Finals held at The Longines Masters of New York. She returned to Findlay as Head Coach three years ago. She holds BS and MS from University of Findlay.



Come by yourself or BRING YOUR WHOLE TEAM! Riders will be divided into lesson groups by Jumping level — IEA jumping division or appropriate skill level. Should be at least IEA Novice level.
