Important Information

Immigration (USCIS) Regulations

- F-1 students must be enrolled full-time
- Students may not be employed off campus without authorization from International Admissions and Services.
- Students may work on campus up to 20 hours per week.
- When travelling outside the US, you must have your I-20 signed by a staff member at International Admissions and Services.
- To reenter the US, you will need: endorsed I-20, valid passport, F-1 Visa, verification of full time status, CPT off-campus work authorization is available after completing 9 months of full time study as an F-1 student.
- Always update your address with the office of International Admissions and Services within 10 days after a move.
- Always be sure that your immigration documents do not expire. If you see they are going to expire, inquire with the International Admissions office to see how to extend the dates.
