

## Important Information

### **Change for MBA students**

As you know, the MBA program will no longer offer live classes in two eight week blocks during a semester. All live classes will be 16 weeks starting Fall 2017. Online classes will still follow the two eight week blocks per semester system. This change affects immigration rules in a couple of ways.



First, because the MBA program will follow the semester system, this means that the Summer semester will ALWAYS be the annual vacation period starting with Summer 2018. There will no longer be a "choice" of when to take the annual vacation.

The live/online rule is still the same. A student can take 9 credits of live classes per semester or 6 credits live and 3 credits online to make 9 credits. If you are approved to take an online class, the full 9 credit registration MUST be registered at the START OF THE SEMESTER even if the online class falls in the second block.

#### **DUI and Visa Revocation**

If you are charged with a DUI you may receive an email from the US Consulate that your visa stamp is revoked. They can only go on the latest contact information for you so if they have the wrong information you may not receive the email, but that does not mean your visa has not been revoked.
