Program Overview

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program prepares students to implement holistic, patient-centered care that reflects an understanding of human growth and development, ethics, pathophysiology, pharmacology, and nursing management across the health-illness continuum, the lifespan and in various healthcare settings.

Our program implements evidence-based nursing interventions as appropriate for managing the acute and chronic care of patients while promoting health and wellness. Students will be prepared to work with an interdisciplinary team of health professionals to positively impact patient outcomes.

Program Highlights

- Newly renovated and expanded Nursing classrooms
- Small class sizes: classes with no more than 30 students, 8:1 student to instructor ratio in clinical setting, 10:1 student to faculty ratio in skills lab
