# Adams County Council of Aging Transportation Services

- Adams County residents aged 60+
- First call-first serve basis for reservation
- Reservation must be made 24 hrs. in advance, but 48 hrs. is preferred
- Trips are offered out of the county, but must be made 2 weeks in advance
- Not permitted to charge fees, but donations based off of distance are accepted

### HOUSING

#### **Swiss Village Retirement Community**

- **Duplex homes** 
  - Independent living style
  - Attached garages
  - Full size kitchen, living/dining room, 2 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, den, and private patio
  - 1359 sq. ft.-1624 sq. ft.
- Independent living apartments
  - Located on main campus of Swiss Village
  - 4 different Hauses
  - For active individuals with an independent lifestyle
  - Full size kitchen, living/dining room, bedroom, bathroom, storage area, and some offer 2 bedrooms with 2 bathrooms
  - 636 sq. ft.-1400 sq. ft.
- Residential living
  - Apartments with provided meals and cleaning services
  - 3 meals a day, housekeeping, and yardwork are done for resident
  - 1 or 2 rooms
  - Nurse call system for emergencies
