


How to access Starfish if you have no classes on your dashboard


<https://canvas.findlay.edu/>: Log into Canvas using your standard username and password

Click on “yes” for the Acceptable Use Policy (note, if you have logged in before, you will not get this message again).


You will start on your blank dashboard that looks like this:




Click on “Courses” (1) and then “All Courses” (2)





Click on the “Browse More Courses” on the right side:

Click "Enroll in Course" and then either "Go to your Dashboard" or "Go to Course"
