



PART-TIME HEALTH INFORMATICS INSTRUCTOR

The University of Findlay's Health Informatics Program invites applications for part-time Health Informatics instructor(s) to serve as a faculty member for on campus courses and/or on line courses. Additional responsibilities may include clinical coordination, administrative tasks and/or assessment activities, depending on the applicant's experience. The start date for this position is January 2018.

The minimum requirement of a master's degree is required but a doctorate is preferred. A Master prepared applicant with appropriate licensure and/or certification and relevant experience will be considered. An applicant with a Master's must possess at least five years of tested experience relevant to department-defined course outcomes, or have a record of research, scholarship or professional achievement in the discipline, or have additional professional credentials (i.e., licensure or certification in a relevant area) and a minimum of two years of tested experience relevant to department-defined course outcomes. Experience in supervising, teaching and scholarship are preferred. The ideal candidate will be an individual that is committed to student-centered education, as well as professional development and service. Strong communication skills and a desire to work with students in a setting that prides itself on providing close relationships between students and faculty are expected.
