### TALK TO A CONFIDENTIAL RESOURCE

#### ON-CAMPUS RESOURCES

**Counseling Services** provides professional, confidential counseling, advocacy, guidance, and assistance in understanding options, rights and outcomes with regard to both the University and criminal processes. 419-434-4526

**Cosiano Health Center** provides medical assistance, including sexual assault response assistance, to students. 419-434-4550

### TALK TO A TRUSTED FRIEND OR MENTOR

Often a friend or mentor is who we first turn to for support, and they can be an important resource.

Please know that if you decide to talk with a UF faculty or staff member, they are required to share information with the TIX coordinator, who will follow up with you to offer resources and support.

If the TIX coordinator follows up with you, it is your choice to respond or not respond.

### TALK TO THE TITLE IX COORDINATOR

In addition to providing information about this policy, the Title IX (TIX) coordinator can provide information on existing counseling, health, mental health, victim advocacy, legal assistance, visa and immigration assistance, student financial aid issues and other services available for individuals as appropriate both on and off campus, regardless of where the prohibited conduct occurred.

The TIX Coordinator can also assist with supportive measures which may be needed.

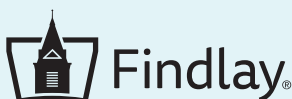
If you meet with the TIX coordinator, you can do any or all of the following:
