Computer Science Alumni Josh Ziegler

Josh Ziegler graduated from the University of Findlay's computer science program in 2010. In 2013, he received an MS in computer science from the Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT) at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base (WPAFB) in Dayton, Ohio.
