McGranahan Bequest to Aid Students

Marjorie and Mildred McGranahan, alumnae of Findlay College/The University of Findlay, have given more than \$1.56 million through a bequest to The University of Findlay to be added to the Marjorie M. McGranahan-Mildred F. McGranahan-Shafer-Van Dorn-McGranahan Scholarship endowment fund.

The McGranahan sisters grew up in a modest, white house in rural McComb, Ohio, with an iconic red barn and other farm buildings out back. Their maternal grandparents, Brainard and Mary (Shafer) Van Dorn, who owned the farm, lived directly across the one-lane road, providing extended family to nurture them.

This bucolic upbringing imprinted Marjorie and Mildred with a love of animals, nature and the land that persisted throughout their lifetimes.

Both women were strong-minded and independent. The sisters graduated

from McComb High School – Mildred as valedictorian – and then attended Findlay College where they were active in student organizations and held leadership positions.

Marjorie, born Sept. 2, 1914, was the older sister, but outlived Mildred, before passing away on Oct. 6, 2013, at age 99. She majored in biology and minored in chemistry and French before graduating from Findlay College in 1937.

While at Findlay, she participated in the YWCA, which was a campus club in those years, where she was president for a semester during her senior year, and she also served a term as secretary for the Women's Athletic Association (WAA). In addition, she was a member of Student Council, Biology Club and Nu Psi Rho, a club for those interested in psychology.

She left northwest Ohio to take graduate classes at the University of

California at Berkley and stayed to teach in the Sacramento area. She told a staff member from The University of Findlay, who visited her in California, that she didn't finish her master's degree because World War II intervened and teachers were needed.

A high school science teacher, she taught in the San Juan Unified School District and was the science department head at Ponderosa High School in Shingle Springs, California.

Being a teacher allowed "Marj," as she preferred to be called, to maintain her ties to the family farm. She returned during summer breaks to help with the work. According to the University staff member, she was passionate about land conservation and environmental issues. Her obituary noted that she was an "amazing teacher" who was a "walking encyclopedia when it came to nature and wildlife."

Marj also volunteered with the Sacramento Zoo and was active in the First United Methodist Church in Roseville, California, and the Mission Oaks Community Center.

In her later years, she resided in an apartment in Roseville, where she was looked after by faithful friends, some of whom were former students.

Mildred, born Sept. 5, 1917, graduated from Findlay College in 1941, majoring in Latin and French, with a minor in commerce.

She distinguished herself as a campus leader by serving as president of Student



Council and the Women's Athletic Association her senior year; holding the position of secretary-treasurer as a senior for the Alethean (philosophy club); and participating in the YWCA, where she was a member of its cabinet for three years. She also was a member of the Argus yearbook staff her junior year.

After teaching a year and working another year at the Findlay-Hancock Public Library, she returned to her lifelong passion – the family farm.

An astute businesswoman and farm manager, "Millie," as she was known by her friends, eventually purchased her own farm and home on St. Rt. 224 west of Findlay, estimated at 120 acres. Purchases by both the sisters enlarged the family farm to more than 500 acres.

Active in the day-to-day activities of farm life, Millie met Paul Fenstermaker in the early 1950s when he was branch manager of Shawtown Elevator. Fenstermaker recalled that he met her when she came to the elevator to have corn ground as feed for her animals.

Over the years, she came to know him as a person she could trust, and in 1974, when her father, Judson Parker "Park" McGranahan, was in his last years, Millie asked Fenstermaker to take over farming their land.

Ultimately, in her later years, she made him power of attorney, and he oversaw her financial affairs, as well. Fenstermaker, along with his two sons, David and Steve, and now, two grandsons, Eric and Tyler, farmed the McGranahan land for 40 years. Paul remembered Millie with great fondness, saying that she raised livestock: cattle, sheep, hogs and chickens.

David Fenstermaker recalled a humorous instance in which he and Millie were giving inoculations to sheep

in the red barn. All of a sudden, he heard her distinctive laugh. He found that she had lost her balance and fallen into the pen, with the sheep then falling down on top of her.

It was a strenuous life for a woman, but one she obviously cherished.

Paul Fenstermaker noted that Millie loved animals, and she kept a German shepherd as a house pet, along with a number of cats.

Dr. C. Richard Beckett, who was the veterinarian for her animals since the 1980s, also remembered the German shepherd and that she loved pets. "Her animals came first whether in the barn or in the house," he said. He estimated that she had 50 to 60 sheep. "At birthing time, it was busy out there at her house," he recalled.

"She had a great deal of common sense, was a caring person," Beckett remarked. He befriended her, visiting her at her farm on St. Rt. 224 and brought her food on various occasions. "She was a fine person, unassuming," he said.

In addition, Millie was active in the Farmers Union, the Ohio Association of Master Gardeners and several garden clubs.

In the late 1980s, Millie established the Shafer-Van Dorn-McGranahan Scholarship at The University of Findlay in honor of the women in her family. Her grandmother, Mary Shafer Van Dorn, and her mother, Zella "Fern" Van Dorn McGranahan, both lived on the farm that was established in 1902.

In creating the scholarship, Millie noted that the funds came from the stewardship of the land and she hoped that the recipients would, in turn, become good stewards of the earth's resources.

She spent her last few years at Sunrise in Findlay before passing away on April 4,

2010. The farmland passed to Marjorie, sustaining her in her final years. Each sister in her will added the other sister's name to the scholarship.

The Fenstermaker family continued to farm the McGranahan land, and purchased it upon Marjorie's death. They are continuing to care for the land, just as the McGranahans intended. "Those ladies were special," Paul said, a little misty-eyed.

And, Marjorie and Mildred McGranahan have ensured that generations of future students at The University of Findlay will continue to be supported in their endeavors to earn an education and that scholarship recipients will be encouraged to be "more aware of mankind's place in the ecosystem" – just as they wanted.

Year in Review – August 1, 2013-July 31, 2014

New Programs

- The first cohort of 25 students was accepted into the new doctor of education (Ed.D.) program in August 2013. Candidates can complete the program totally online with attendance at an annual, weeklong summer institute required. Approved by the Ohio Board of Regents in 2012 and the Higher Learning Commission in 2013, the Ed.D. is offered through the College of Education. Students can focus on one of two areas: superintendent or teaching and learning. The program can be completed in three years (maximum seven years) and features strong dissertation support. A doctor of education is highly advantageous in positions such as school and district administrators, curriculum developers, teacher leaders and higher education faculty.

New People

- Marjorie Walker, Ed.D., RN, MSN, joined the College of Health Professions as the Department of Nursing chair in summer 2013, with the new nursing program launched in August 2014. Walker brings 20-plus years of nursing education, teaching and administrative experience to The University of Findlay. She received her doctor of education from Argosy University, Sarasota, Florida; a master of science in nursing from West Virginia University, Morgantown, West Virginia; and a bachelor of science in nursing from Ohio University, Athens, Ohio. Previously, Walker had served as director of nursing and associate professor at Ohio Northern University, Ada, Ohio, and as dean of nursing at James A. Rhodes State College, Lima, Ohio.

- Marcia Sloan Latta, Ed.D., joined the University as the vice president for University Advancement on Aug. 28, 2013. Her prior experience in higher education includes serving as vice president for advancement at DePauw University, vice president of the Bowling Green State University (BGSU) Foundation, and senior associate vice president for advancement at BGSU. Latta received a Certified Fund Raising Executive designation in 1995. She holds a master's and bachelor's degree in communication and a doctor of education in leadership and policy studies from BGSU. Active in the Council for Advancement and Support of Education (CASE), she is also past president of the Northwest Ohio Chapter of the Association of Fund Raising Professionals.

- After serving as interim dean since 2012, Jeffrey Frye, Ph.D. became the dean of the College of Sciences in May 2014. Frye joined The University of Findlay in 1991 as an assistant professor of chemistry. He had continued to teach, while serving as an area director of chemistry, physics, geology and natural science and as chair of the department of physical sciences. Prior to joining UF, Frye was in a post-doctoral position at the former Medical College of Ohio. He has a Ph.D. in chemistry from Miami University and a bachelor of science in biochemistry from Juniata College, Huntingdon, Pennsylvania.

- John Osae-Kwapong, Ph.D. became The University of Findlay's new associate vice president for academic affairs and institutional effectiveness in July 2014. Osae-Kwapong provides

leadership, administrative oversight and coordination for campus-wide assessment and academic strategic initiatives. He also will develop institutional policies and protocols that facilitate a culture of continuous improvement and innovation. Previously, he served as director of planning and research at Columbia University, New York, and director of planning, assessment and research at The Graduate School, Washington, D.C. Osae-Kwapong received a doctorate in political science from George Mason University, Fairfax, Virginia; master of public administration from Clark Atlanta University in Atlanta, Georgia; and a bachelor of arts in political science from Houghton College, Houghton, New York.

- Ronald Tulley, Ph.D. became the dean of the College of Liberal Arts in July 2014. He had held several teaching and administrative positions at UF since 2002. Most recently, he was an associate professor of English and the interim director for online learning. Prior to joining The University of Findlay, Tulley taught at Case Western Reserve University, Bowling Green State University, Pierce College in Lakewood, Washington, and other colleges in Washington and Illinois. He received the Harriette Smith Ritz Award for Service to the University in 2013 and was the Richard E. Wilkin Faculty Chair in the College of Liberal Arts in 2012-2013.

Distinguished Visitors

- Dr. Kazuyuki Katayama, consulate general of Japan in Detroit, visited



The University of Findlay on Dec. 9, 2013. His visit was part of a day-long itinerary in the City of Findlay. After his presentation, Dr. Katayama attended a reception at the Mazza Museum where he met with administrators, faculty, staff, Japanese students and those studying Japanese at UF.

- Francois Delattre, ambassador of France, visited campus on April 23, 2014. Ambassador Delattre discussed global economic issues and bilateral relations with a large audience in the Winebrenner Theological Seminary TLB Auditorium. UF rep, Bob Latta (R-OH) of Ohio's Fifth Congressional District, coordinated the visit. Prior to the Ambassador's presentation, hospitality management students from The University of Findlay and students from the culinary arts program at Owens Community College prepared a luncheon for the guests, served in the Mazza Museum.
- Koby Koomson, former ambassador of Ghana to the United States, visited The University of Findlay on June 13, 2014, in an energy "fact finding" mission. Koomson and representatives from Green & Energy Operations, Detroit, and Greensleeves LLC, Findlay, convened to discuss the geothermal system in the University's new Davis Street Building science addition. Energy issues are having a negative impact on Ghana's economy and the former ambassador is collecting information to address this. The American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers named the Davis Building's geothermal system the "best in the

world for a new educational building" for 2014.

- Diane Jorkasky, M.D., a nationally recognized medical scientist and researcher in the pharmaceutical industry, was on campus in March 2014 as The University of Findlay's fourth Woodrow Wilson Visiting Fellow, sponsored by the Council of Independent Colleges. She gave presentations primarily for the College of Pharmacy, but also addressed women in leadership topics. Dr. Jorkasky is president of her own research and development consulting business after holding vice president-level positions with several international pharmaceutical companies. She also has served on the faculties of Yale University, University of Pennsylvania and the University of California.

Milestones

- The first "Women in Philanthropy" program was held in The Winebrenner Theological Seminary TLB Auditorium on campus on Oct. 12, 2013. Initiated by Dr. Kathy Krendl, president of Otterbein University; Dr. Mary Ellen Mazey, president of Bowling Green State University; and Dr. Katherine Fell, president of The University of Findlay, the seminar focused on the power of women to impact their communities. More than 120 people attended the program to hear presentations, panel discussions and the keynote address by the Honorable Betty Montgomery, Ohio's first woman attorney general.
- Earl and Gladys DeLong, Tiffin, Ohio, created a \$1 million unrestricted gift to The University of Findlay

through a joint charitable gift annuity. President Katherine Fell announced the gift in November 2013. The DeLongs have been generous over the years, supporting building projects on campus, including the DeLong Creativity and Presentation Room in Old Main and a major contribution to the lobby renovation of Egner Center for the Performing Arts.

- In June 2014, The University of Findlay announced that it had pledged to join the Institute of International Education's Generation Study Abroad Initiative to double the number of American students who study abroad by the end of the decade. The initiative also focuses on increasing the diversity of the students who study abroad, ensuring quality and removing barriers to participation.
- The College of Business earned accreditation in November 2013 from the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP), which is the leading specialized accreditation association for business education for all degree levels worldwide. The accounting and finance programs also earned endorsement in early 2014 by the Institute of Management Accountants (IMA), one of the largest and most respected associations focused on advancing the management accounting profession. The Intensive English Language Program earned accreditation in April 2014 from the Commission on English Language Program Accreditation (CEA), which is recognized as the national accrediting agency for English language programs and institutions in the United States.

Funding to Assist Students is a Top Priority

Donors play a critical role in making a quality education at The University of Findlay affordable for today's students. Endowed funds provide scholarship aid, enrich academic programs and help faculty stay current in their academic fields. These funds are created through the vision of donors who understand the need and make gifts that have an impact far into the future. Endowed funds can be established during the donor's lifetime or through a bequest. Either way, these donors leave a legacy that secures the future for both the institution and generations of students.

Currently, 99 percent of UF students receive some form of financial aid. Our goal is for students to graduate with the least amount of debt possible. We are encouraged that the average debt of our graduates has dropped over the past two years to \$25,584 and our average student loan default rates are significantly below the national and state averages. Donors have played an important role in these successes by providing more than \$7.6 million in endowed funds since 2006.

Endowed funds

During Aug. 1, 2013-July 31, 2014, 11 new funds were created and 19 funds became fully endowed, each with a principal that amounts to \$10,000 or more. A total of 451 donors contributed \$2,362,236 to the University's endowment funds.

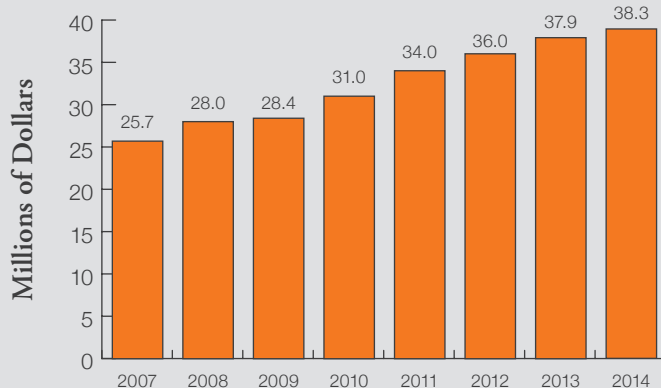

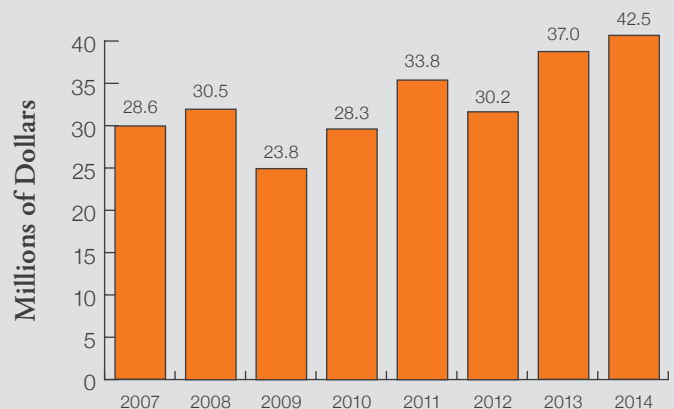

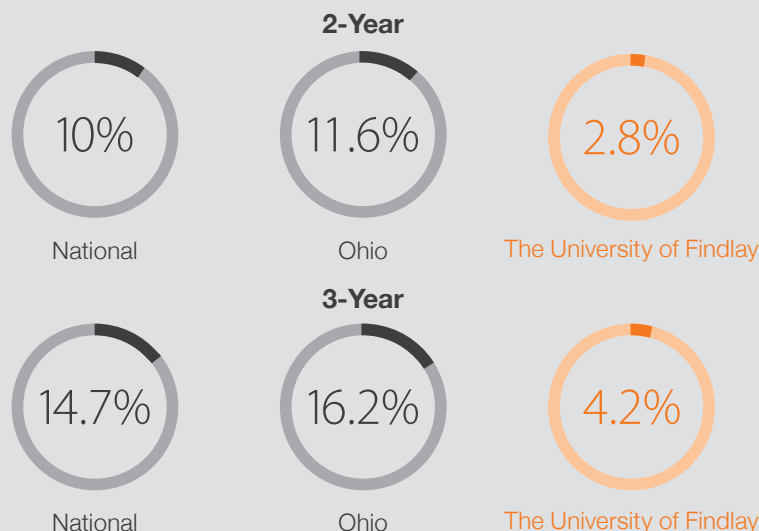


Class of 1964 reunion.

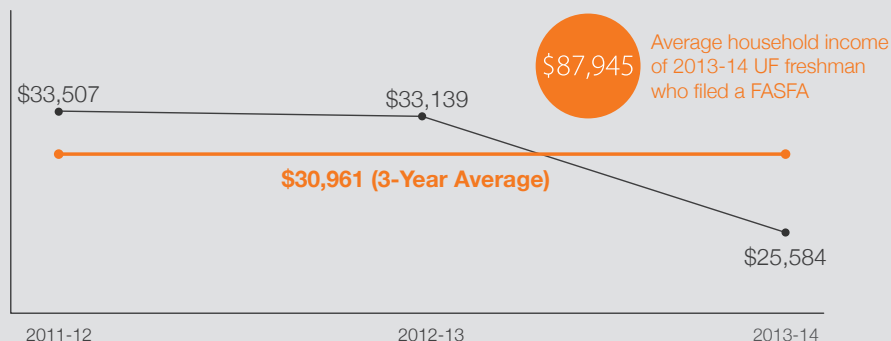


Class of 1974 reunion.

Average Debt of UF Graduates



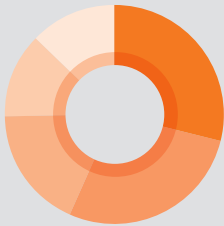

Contributions Total Nearly \$6 Million for 2013-14

Total gifts and new pledges for Aug. 1, 2013 – July 31, 2014, amounted to \$4.7 million. Contributions and gifts received during the period totaled \$5.97 million from 2,784 donors, of whom 1,315 were alumni.

As of July 31, 2014, the *Give Voice to Your Values* comprehensive campaign reached \$46,453,887 toward the goal of \$50 million. The momentum of the campaign continues to be strong with 93 percent of the goal reached.

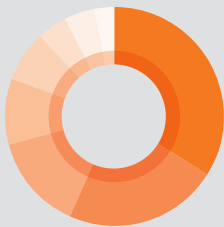
The campaign continues to focus on raising funds for a new learning space for the College of Business, with the new building also incorporating expanded room for a student life center. Increasing scholarship funds remains an emphasis in recruiting and retaining outstanding students.

Endowed funds established during the past year amounted to \$2.36 million to support scholarships, programs and faculty development.

Publicly launched on Sept. 30, 2010, the national campaign has emphasized the values of integrity, service, responsibility, respect, dedication, excellence and generosity in support of enhanced learning environments, endowment and annual operating monies essential to achieving the University's goals.

A.R. ('66) and Mary Ann Charnes serve as campaign co-chairs. The campaign is scheduled to conclude July 31, 2015.

The Findlay Fund

Total giving to The Findlay Fund for fiscal year 2013-14 was \$407,079, of which \$31,832 went toward The Findlay Fund Scholarships, which are one-year operating scholarships. The number of alumni donors increased to 1,360, which is 108 more than the previous year.

The UF Outreach (phonathon) was successful in raising \$83,520 during 2013-14, up nearly \$30,000 from last year. The average gift size increased to \$87, up from \$52 the year prior.

Several initiatives were successful in boosting participation in the annual fund. The University of Findlay Board of Trustees participation in The Findlay Fund was 100 percent, and the Alumni Association Board of Governors also had 100 percent participation.

An employee campaign for The Findlay Fund during 2013-14 was launched, called "100% Oilers." Faculty and staff members responded, with

70 percent making a gift in support of students. The percentage of employee participation increased from 41.9 percent the previous year, with 427 employees giving \$160,171.

Giving by parents to The Findlay Fund accounted for \$24,111. A Parent Executive Council was formed to give guidance on initiatives to further enhance the student experience.

Increasing alumni participation continues to be a goal with significant impact. The University of Findlay's alumni giving percentage is lower than average. Grant-awarding entities, such as foundations, corporations and government agencies consider alumni giving percentage as a part of their formulas for awarding funds. Alumni can help by giving each year to The Findlay Fund. A gift of any amount counts toward the alumni giving percentage. Every gift makes a difference.

Findlay Fund Scholarships

There are three new ways to provide scholarship support for students:

- 1) The Findlay Fund Scholarship: donor contributions are pooled to create scholarship awards for students.
- 2) The Findlay Fund Named Scholarships: established through a gift of \$2,500 or more, scholarships may be named for the donor or someone of their designation. Named scholarships are awarded to one student for a single year.
- 3) Oiler Promise Endowed Scholarships: funded with a gift of \$25,000 or more, providing unrestricted scholarships support on a continuing basis, year after year.

Grant Awards Total \$2.5 Million

Funding of grant proposals by faculty and staff amounted to more than \$2.5 million for fiscal year 2013-14. Thirty-four grant proposals were submitted, with 22 awarded and three pending. Grant monies are crucial in moving programs forward beyond what is provided for by operating budgets.

Among the awards were:

- \$1,193,983 awarded to Drs. Bethany Henderson-Dean, Julie McIntosh, Judy Wahrman and Pam Warton from the National Science Foundation's Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program to groom undergraduates and working professionals as math and science teachers to work in schools that serve many low-income students.
- \$385,000 awarded to the College of Education, the College of Science and the College of Pharmacy from the Ohio Board of Regents' Choose Ohio First program to provide scholarships to students enrolled in computer science, biology, education or pharmacy programs.
- \$367,491 awarded to the Office of Internships and Placement and Owens Community College-Findlay Campus from the Ohio Board of Regents' Ohio Means Internships and Co-Ops program to increase the capacity of both institutions to place students in meaningful, career goal-driven and academically-aligned experiential learning opportunities.
- \$162,500 awarded to the College of Education from Ohio Educator Preparation Program Performance Grant, funded through Ohio's Race to the Top grant from the United States Department of Education, to offer professional development opportunities to area educators.
- \$149,340 awarded to the Office of Internships and Placement from Great Lakes Higher Education Guaranty Corporation to provide more than 60 paid internships for qualified juniors, seniors, and rising juniors.
- \$93,316 awarded to Drs. Ben Dolan, Bethany Henderson-Dean, and Donald Walker from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to reconstruct wetlands at the UF Rieck Center for Habitat Studies that will aid in reducing agriculture-related pollution levels in the Blanchard River. This award is part of the federal Great Lakes Restoration Initiative.
- \$81,449 awarded to Kay Koch, director of the Oiler Success Center, from Great Lakes Higher Education Guaranty Corporation to support interventions such as peer mentors and increased use of the University's Starfish Early Alert system to keep UF's at-risk, first-year students on the path to graduation.
- \$18,400 awarded to Dr. Ryan Schneider from LI-COR Biosciences to purchase new equipment that can be used in the College of Pharmacy's Western Blotting course.
- \$10,939 awarded to Dr. Hiroaki Kawamura from the Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation to conduct a service-learning project with area high school students as part of the communitywide efforts to increase community internationalization among youth, adults, employers and educators.

Audited Financial Statement

Financial results for the fiscal year from Aug. 1, 2013, until July 31, 2014, continued to be favorable. The operating budget was balanced, with a change in net assets from operations of \$10.3 million. About \$7.4 million from the operating budget was targeted to reduce debt and invested in selected projects to strengthen academic programs and improve facilities.
