

# March 16 Campus Update Regarding Corona Virus Response

To the UF Community:

Good morning. As we continue to navigate the current situation, we would like to provide a brief update this morning. This afternoon, a more detailed email will be sent covering a variety of topics.

- Yesterday, Governor DeWine ordered restaurants to suspend inside dining in order to limit indoor group gatherings. Henderson Dining Hall and the Refinery are subject to this ruling, which means that people may not dine in those areas while this is in effect. Individuals can still go to Henderson and the Refinery to select their food, but the items will be placed in a take-out container so they can be consumed in another location.
- The Office of Housing and Residence Life remains committed to helping students plan their housing accommodations for the fall 2020 semester. The housing selection process for returning students will follow the original timeline that begins March 18 with the selection of single occupancy apartment units. All information with regard on how to sign up for housing has been emailed to students. Please refer to those messages for exact details, or contact the Student Affairs Office at 419-434-4570.
- Registration for fall 2020 is underway. Students can check MyFindlay for their registration date. During this time of remote learning, academic advisers are still able to register students. If students cannot reach their adviser and/or would like guidance on scheduling classes for fall, the Oiler Success Center is available to assist. - As a reminder, the last day to withdraw from classes is Monday, March 23.
